

NO Aggressive Dogs at Agility

You cannot bring an aggressive dog to agility classes.

We know that the Beginner Dogs can be overly enthusiastic and we know that you may be an inexperienced handler with little control. That is Okay with your instructors.

However, we cannot include dogs who are a threat to other dogs or persons.

- IF YOUR DOG IS AGGRESSIVE (angry snarling, snapping or biting, regardless of the reason) WITH PEOPLE OR OTHER DOGS, YOU HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY TO GET PROFESSIONAL HELP FOR YOU AND YOUR DOG. YOU NEED TO SOLVE THIS PROBLEM FIRST, before you and your dog can happily and safely mix with other dogs and people.
- YOU ARE 100% RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR DOG'S BEHAVIOUR ALL THE TIME, EVERY TIME.
- DOGS DON'T "GROW OUT" OF AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOUR
- AGILITY CLASSES WITH INEXPERIENCED AND EXCITED HANDLERS AND DOGS ARE NOT THE PLACE FOR YOU AND YOUR AGGRESSIVE DOG.
