Beginners' Lessons

- An introduction to the concepts of agility, including training techniques and equipment
- 5 lessons - 6 if there is no rain cancellation! One lesson on the weekend, one lesson on a weeknight, with an additional orientation session (without dogs)
- Small groups – maximum 6 dogs with 2 instructors
- \$50 for 5 lessons
- After 5 lessons, you can choose to sign up for 5 additional lessons.

Intermediate Lessons

- For people and dogs who have already participated in beginner agility lessons
- A wide variety of skills can be accommodated.
- Approximately 10 dogs in the group
- One lesson on the weekend, one lesson during the week, and open practice time
- \$80 includes participation to the beginning of July

Location

- All lessons will be held at the end of the parking lot area at the Tommy Forrest Ballpark
- We will use the Ballpark whenever the ball schedule permits - usually not much time available until July
